ARTS SPACE

A venue for artistic creation and experimentation in the performing arts, visual arts, and music. Spanning over 3,000 square meters, its large and flexible areas accommodate rehearsals and experiments of all kinds within the arts, as well as courses and lectures.

LABORATORY THEATER

A space for teaching and experimentation in the performing arts that regularly hosts rehearsals, productions, and shows created by the students themselves, with performances free of charge to the public.

SPECIALIZED LABORATORIES

Photography, video and film capture, visual media, image processing, audio capture and processing, editing, musical acoustics, creative writing, and journalism.
