

NOTICE ATAECA /ECA-USP/16/2024

The Dean of the Escola de Comunicações e Artes da Universidade de São Paulo announces the opening of one faculty PhD Professor positions, in Full-Time Dedication to Teaching and Research (RDIDP in the Portuguese acronym), specialty “Image” (nº 1242687 full-time service). The position requires a commitment to teaching and the ability to conduct independent research. Applications will be accepted between May 6, 2024 at 8:30 a.m., to July 4, 2024 at 4 p.m. (GMT-3). The entry-level monthly salary is R\$14.761,02 (May/2023) plus benefits.

The public competition will cover the following program:

Program: “Image”

1. Exposure and the relationships between its various parameters in image construction;
2. Photographic language and technical syntax of audiovisual systems;
3. Optical systems during the capture, editing, and display of audiovisual content;
4. Equipment for camera movement and image stabilization;
5. Illuminating devices, filters, and other means of light control;
6. Processing, storing and distribution of digital images;
7. Camera operation techniques, color space, and gamma curves;
8. Post-production, treatment, and finalization of still and moving images;
9. Camera formats and electronic capture systems;
10. Technical workflow in productions with electronic capture, from pre-production to post-production;
11. Manipulation, encoding, and decoding of static and moving digital images;
12. The image team and its dynamics in productions with electronic capture, from pre-production to post-production.

The public competition will be governed by Brazilian constitutional principles, notably that of Impersonality, as well as by the Statute and the General Regulations of the Universidade de São Paulo and the Regulations of the Escola de Comunicações e Artes.

Candidates are required to apply online, at the website <https://uspdigital.usp.br/gr/admissao>, in the period indicated above. Candidates must submit their personal information (name, RG, CPF, nationality, marital status, landline and cellphone numbers, residential and electronic addresses), and indication as to the knowledge area (Image) along with the following documents:

I – detailed memorial and proof of published works, relevant activities regarding the selection process, and any other information allowing for an evaluation of merits, in digital format;

II – proof that the candidate holds a Ph.D.’s degree, granted or acknowledged by USP, or nationally acknowledged (Brazilian acknowledged);

III – proof of discharge from military service for male candidates;

IV – voter registration card or Electoral discharge certificate or detailed certificate issued by the Electoral Court less than 30 days before the start of the application period;

V – Official identification document (front and back).

The selection process will occur according to objective criteria, in two stages, by attribution of scores in exams, and thus divided:

- 1st stage (eliminary):

I) Written exam (weight 2)

- 2nd stage:

I) Evaluation of the memorial with a public argumentation exam (weight 3)

II) Didactic exam (weight 3)

III) Practical Exam (weight 2)

Description of the practical exam:

I – The practical exam will consist of assembling equipment, lighting, and capturing a video scene according to a set of instructions. Participants are required to deliver the captured files along with a camera report. Instructions and materials will be provided by the viva.

II - The candidate will have a maximum of ninety minutes to complete practical exam.

III – The practical exam will be conducted individually. The registration order will be followed for the examination.

IV - The use of personal devices during the exam will not be allowed.
